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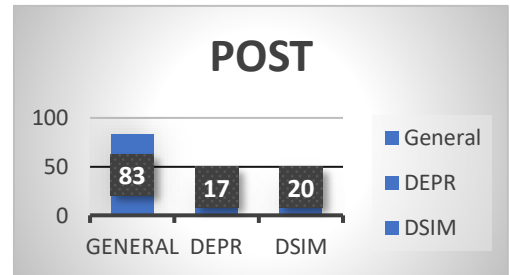

- **Option 1:** Postgraduate degree in any discipline with minimum 55% marks (50% for SC/ST/PwBD)
- **Option 2:** Graduate degree in any discipline with minimum 60% marks (50% for SC/ST/PwBD)

- Indian citizen, Subject of Nepal/Bhutan, Tibetan refugee (came to India before 1st Jan 1962),
- Indian origin person from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, or Vietnam

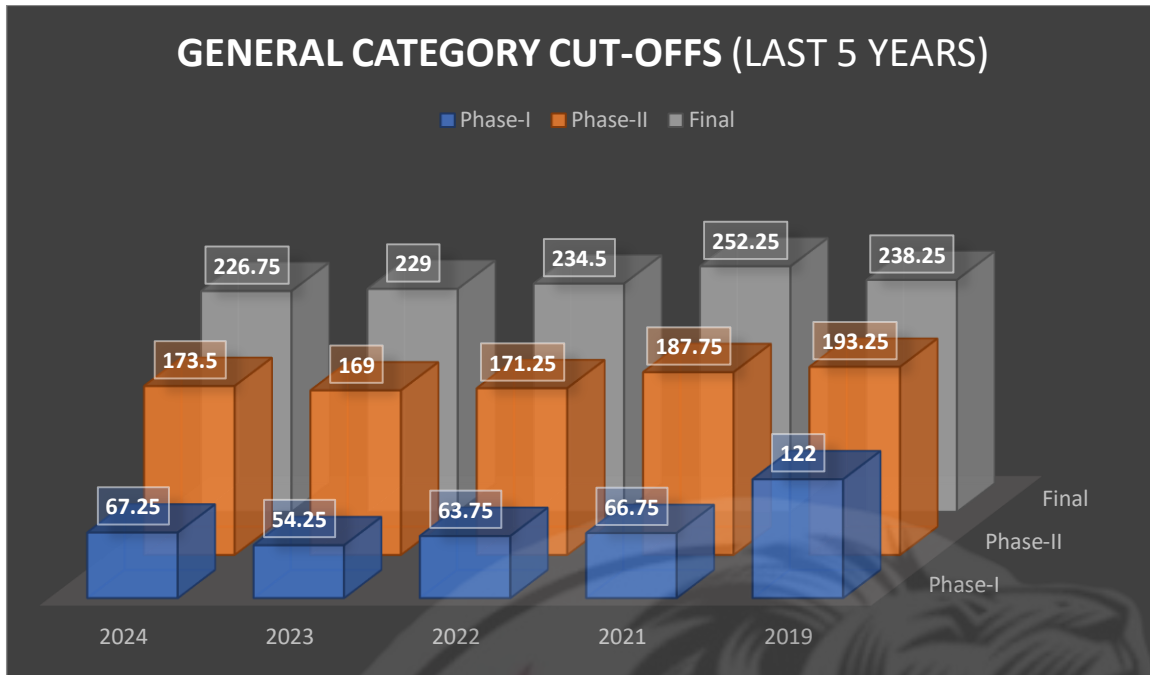

Selection Process

- Merit-based final selection
- Category-wise merit lists
- Reserve list for future vacancies
- Validity period: Usually 1 year

Waiting List Features

- Prepared category-wise
- Called as per vacancy availability
- Same pay scale and benefits
- Medical examination required
